User roles in the new KiVa intranet for a KiVa school

- 1. Coordinator
- 2. Teacher



Coordinator has access to:

- School profile (own school only) including also KiVa materials
- Announcements
- User database
- Games
- Instructions

Can add and remove colleagues' user IDs

Both **school principals** and **KiVa coordinators** have a coordinator level ID in the new intranet.



Coordinator can



- View and edit own school details (address, number of students etc.)
- View own school survey results
- Add and delete other own school coordinators
- View KiVa materials (for teaching)
- Read announcements
- Access games' user management



Teacher has access to:



- School profile
- Materials
- Announcements
- Games
- Instructions



Teacher can

- View own school details (but not edit)
- View KiVa materials (for teaching)
- Read announcements
- Access games' user management
